

REGISTRO PARROQUIAL

Para permitirnos servirle mejor, todos los feligreses deben registrarse en la oficina parroquial. Si usted es un nuevo feligrés, o un feligrés actual que se mudó o cambió de número de teléfono, por favor contacte a la Oficina Parroquial.

Los miembros de la familia de 23 años o más deben registrarse por separado como individuos, incluso si continúan viviendo con sus padres. Debe ser un feligrés registrado para ser un Patrocinador de Confirmación o un Padrino.

REQUISITOS PARA SER PADRINO/PATROCINADOR DE CONFIRMACIÓN Debe ser un feligrés ACTIVO, REGISTRADO por un mínimo de seis meses que asista a misa semanalmente y contribuya al apoyo de la Iglesia, de acuerdo con los medios de uno.

REGISTRATION

To enable us to better serve you, all parishioners should register at the Parish Office. If you are a new parishioner, or a current parishioner who has moved or changed phone numbers, please contact the Parish Office.

Family members 23 years or older should register separately as individuals even if continuing to live with their parents. You must be a registered parishioner to be a Confirmation Sponsor or a Godparent.

*GODPARENT/CONFIRMATION SPONSOR **REQUIREMENTS***

Must be an ACTIVE, REGISTERED parishioner for a minimum of six months, who attends Mass weekly, and contributes to the support of the Church, in accordance with one's means.

Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation.

If married, must be in a marriage recognized as valid by the Catholic Church.

Must live a Christian life consistent with the role of godparent or sponsor.

advises those trying to cope with a loss not to bury their feelings, but rather to go through the pain of death and look toward the new life God has provided.



Dear Friend,

In football they have a "huddle."

The goal of the huddle is to give you thirty seconds to call the play, that is why they give you a huddle.

At a professional football game there may be sixty thousand people watching you huddle, they don't mind you taking thirty seconds to call the play.

They understand that you have to get organized, you have to know where you are going to go, the ends need to know where they are going to go, the quarterback needs to know where he is going to go, the backs need to know where they are going to go.

A huddle is a necessary part of playing the game.

But let us be assured, if we do not already know, sixty thousand people do not pay to watch us huddle.

We understand that people do not come to football games to watch the huddle.

They want to see if their team can overcome the opposition who is daring them to snap the ball and move down the field to score.

What they want to know is does your practice work?

Now what Catholics too often do is get "high" on their huddles.

We become content over the huddle!

But what we so often forget is, that the huddle is so that we can play the "game" we call life.

The effectiveness of our Catholic Faith cannot be measured only by Sunday morning.

The test of our Catholic Faith is how we live it at home, in school, at work, in the community and in our commitment to our parish.

What we will always need are Catholics that are representatives of Jesus Christ not only when gathered but when disseminated.

Let us pray always and never lose heart.
